2	CITY	VARCHAR(35)	The name of the city designated by the USPS.
3	STATE	CHAR(2)	The two-letter abbreviation for the state to that particular ZIP code.
4	AREA_CODE	VARCHAR(40)	The telephone area code belonging to the particular ZIP code is located.

### **1. ZIP\_CODE**

A five-digit code (00000-99999) which identifies a specific geographic delivery area. ZIP also known as “Zone Improvement Plan”. ZIP Codes represent an area within a state or a single building or company with high mail volume. In very rare case, a ZIP Code shares different states boundaries.

### **2. CITY**

This is the name of USPS preferred city. It is used at the last line of postal address. The name can represent a city, a postal entity, a community or a municipality name.

### **3. STATE**

The 2-letter abbreviation represents the name of the state or US Territory. For example, AZ stands for Arizona and CA stands for California.

### **4. AREA\_CODE**

The telephone area code belonging to the particular ZIP code is located.
